INDIA TRAINING CAMP Frequently Asked Questions

What is the climate like? The academy we base the majority of the training camp is in Dehradun, in the foothills of the Himalayas. The temperatures are milder and much more suited to high volume of cricket than in the cities like Mumbai and Bangalore, the air is also much cleaner than in the major cities.

What is the food like? While at the academy the on site chefs will cater for all dietary requirements and cook plain food for those not wanting to eat Indian food every day. While in Delhi there are many western options, so it is easy to avoid spicy food.

How much travelling is involved? While there is extra travelling to get to Dehradun from Delhi, once we are there all the cricket is on one site – so no long daily bus trips to the cricket like there would be on most city based cricket tours.

Can parents come along? Yes, parents and supporters are welcome. The academy is situated in a nice part of India and ideal for excursions and sightseeing while the players are training.

Can young players travel alone? Yes, having done this tour since 2018 we are experienced chaperones. We will provide necessary paperwork for handover of responsibility.

Who books the flights? As this isn't a team tour we price it excluding flights. However, to keep things as simple as possible we source the flights and send out booking links so that we end up on the same flight. You do have the option of choosing your own flights and meeting us in Delhi.

What type of player is this suitable for? All players must be capable hard ball cricketers with aspirations to develop their game. Most players attending play at least some sort of local representative cricketers.

Is there an age range? A general guide is 11-21, but as it's an individual tour it is open to anyone.

Will they train as one group at the Academy? No, touring players will mix in with the resident Indian cricketers of similar standard. They have juniors groups through to senior groups with state level u21 players.

Can girls attend? Absolutely yes, there will be chance to train with Indian girls who train at the academy.

Can players stay for longer? Yes, we can arrange for extended stays at the academy.

What vaccines will I need? Check with your local doctor.

Will we need a visa? Yes, this can be done easily online.

Can players with Pakistani heritage or nationality attend? Yes, however the process of obtaining a visa cannot be done online, so therefore this is more time consuming.

Will we play matches? Yes, we play a floodlit game in Delhi. We also play simulated practice matches and at the academy and players can join in with the Indian teams playing in matches.
